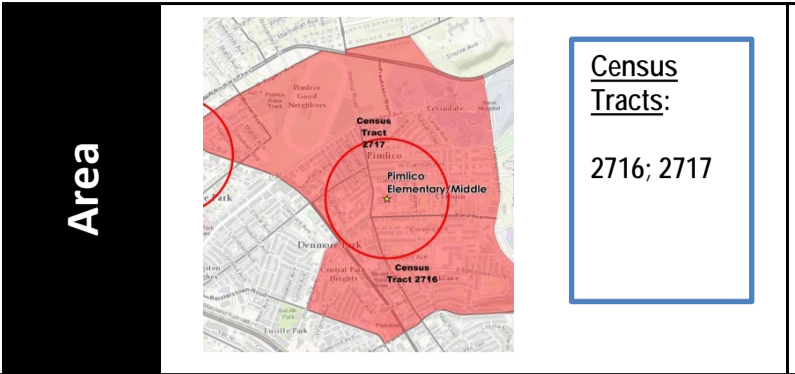


Pimlico Elementary/Middle School - Social and Demographic Profile
